What data is collected and processed by the vote-anyway.org website?

We process 3 different types of data about you:

- Your email address
- Your participation: we save the content you create on the questionnaire
- Your activity on the website: we store the data on your activity on the website, such as which pages you visit, your language preferences, the contributions you supported and the content you read, in order to show you personalised and relevant content.

Where is this data stored?

Data collected: When you choose to subscribe to the newsletter, your email address is collected by Civocracy. This personal data will only be used for the purpose of receiving the newsletter. How long is my data stored for?

Civocracy stores your participation data on <u>vote-anyway.org</u> for up to 5 years. We keep it that long to be able to analyse it and make your project impactful over time!

At the end of this time period, we ask for renewal of consent. Without your consent all personal data is deleted, and your contributions will be made anonymous.

Users' rights



In keeping with the GDPR's intention to help Users gain control over their personal data, the Civocracy website ensures that all 8 rights laid out in in chapter 3 of the GDPR are complied with, namely:

- 1. the right to be informed about how Users' data is being processed.
- 2. the right of access to information about any of their personal data being processed.
- 3. the right to rectification in the case of inaccurate information.
- 4. the right to erasure or "the right to be forgotten".
- 5. the right to restrict processing by way of requesting a company to refrain from processing data for specific purposes.
- 6. the right to data portability by way of requesting a copy of any personal data that is being processed.
- 7. the right to object to the processing of data.
- 8. right related to automated decision-making and profiling
